Great Lakes Scrip Policy

Objective:

To provide a means for students and their families to defer fees while participating in the instrumental music programs sponsored by William Tennent High School ("WTHS").

Policy:

- Orders can only be placed by William Tennent Music Boosters Association ("WTMBA") members.
- WTMBA members must sign a WTMBA Scrip Program Agreement to participate.
- Family rebates will be held and managed by the WTMBA Treasurer.
- Student WTMBA accounts will be credited 80% of their total rebate from this program with the remaining 20% deposited to the WTMBA General Fund to defray the administrative costs of this program.
- Families with multiple students in the instrumental music programs shall designate how the rebate shall be split between their students.
- Rebates accumulated and not utilized will be transferred within families to a sibling when the current student leaves the instrumental music program. If a family does not have a sibling participating in the instrumental music program within one year of the current student, the remaining rebate will be donated by the WTMBA member family to the WTMBA General Fund and used at the discretion of the WTMBA.
- The ShopWithScrip Program Coordinator will submit a monthly report to the WTMBA Treasurer with a listing of the total family rebate and student name, and each student's 80%/20% proportionate share. The schedule for this report shall be established between the Scrip Coordinator and the WTMBA Treasurer.

What is Scrip?

Scrip is a fundraising tool for non-profit organizations like the WTMBA. Money is earned by using gift cards to pay for everyday purchases. The Scrip program is setup so individual families can earn rebates for their student's WTMBA accounts that can be used toward instrumental program fees and events while participating in the instrumental music programs at WTHS.

How does Scrip work?

WTMBA families buy plastic or electronic gift cards at full face value, and use them in place of cash, checks or credit cards for everyday shopping. The WTMBA buys them from Great Lakes Scrip Center at a reduced cost. The difference between the costs is a rebate that becomes fundraising for your student.

Shop With Scrip Family Online Ordering

WTMBA families will order scrip on-line by registering through ShopWithScrip using PrestoPay*. Electronic gift cards are available for use almost immediately; an email from the ShopWithScrip organization will be sent to the WTMBA family member, usually within 2 hours, indicating that the electronic card is available for use. Plastic gift card orders will be ordered monthly by the WTMBA Scrip Coordinator on a predetermined date schedule to be published as needed. WTMBA families will be contacted by the WTMBA Scrip Coordinator when your order is ready for pickup.

* PrestoPay is a secure electronic payment via debit to your checking account. It is managed through the Great Lakes Scrip Center ShopWithScrip program manager and not by the WTMBA. It is subject to insufficient funds fees from both ShopWithScrip and the WTMBA bank, which shall be payable by the WTMBA family.
